About the barrels

- ◆ Provider: Upcycle Products Inc.
- ◆ Size: 55 Gallons, regular or wide-overflow
- ◆ Colors: Terra Cotta, Black, Blue, and Gray.
- ◆ The rain barrels are made from food quality high density poly ethylene barrels that were previously used for food.
- ◆ The barrels have a screw on top with one inch holes, screen mesh to keep out debris and mosquitoes, an overflow male hose connection, a drain valve and a connection to attach additional barrels.
- ◆ The shapes will vary depending on what barrels are available for upcycling at the time of order.

What is a Rain Barrel?

A rain barrel is a system that collects and stores rainwater from your roof that would otherwise be lost to runoff and diverted to storm drains and streams.

Rain Barrel water using tips

- The water can be used to water your flowers, trees, shrubs, and lawn, wash your car, rinse tools or muddy boots, clean off siding, and hose down the driveway.
- Due to lack of research data, rain barrel water is not recommended for watering fruit or vegetable gardens.
- Do not drink, cook or bathe with water from your rain barrel. Do not use the water to wash fruits or vegetables prior to consumption.

Decorating Rain Barrels

If you want, you can paint or decorate your rain barrels to make them more attractive. Below are pictures of some rain barrels decorated by school students at the past NWI Earth Day rain barrel decorating contest.



Benefits of Rain Barrels

1. Saves You Money

A rain barrel can save most homeowners about 1,300 gallons of water during the peak summer months. Saving water not only helps protect the environment, it saves you money and energy (decreased demand for treated tap water).

2. Helps Reduce Runoff & Pollution

Rainwater stored in rain barrels helps reduce peak volume, velocity and the amount of stormwater runoff reaching lakes and rivers. Less amount of runoff also carries less amount of pollutants to water bodies.

3. Conserves Water Supply Resources

Lawn and garden watering make up nearly 40% of total household water use during the summer. Rainwater used from rain barrels helps reduce the amount of water used from underground aquifers.

4. Better for Plants and Gardens

Rainwater stored in rain barrels is a naturally soft water and devoid of minerals, chlorine, fluoride, and other chemicals. For this reason, plants respond very well to rainwater. After all, it's what plants in the wild thrive on!

5. You'll be an inspiring example of environmental stewardship.

Rain Barrel instructions

- It is a good idea to put your barrel up on a flat, stable platform (concrete blocks, landscaping blocks or other solid support). The added height increases the water pressure and allows you to put a bucket under the spigot to get water. A full 55 gallon rain barrel weighs over 450 pounds.
- Locate and install your rain barrel to keep kids safe. Keep your rain barrel lid tight at all times to prevent children, animals and insects from entering or falling in.
- Measure and cut the downspout. Use the existing elbow or a flexible spout attachment to direct the water to the top of the barrel. The end of the downspout should be cut 6-8 inches above the top of the barrel. Downspouts can be cut with a hacksaw. Flexible spouts can be purchased at hardware stores or home centers.
- Install an overflow hose to direct water away from your house foundation for times of high rainfall. Diverters are available that can easily switch the downspout from filling the barrel to normal operation once the barrel is full.
- In the fall, empty your rain barrel and then leave the valve (spigot) open. Remove the cap on the lower fitting. Leave the barrel in place and in the Spring just close the valve and install the cap.
